- Site map is a JSON file (GPS data included) and can be a google map image or a custom image provided by the customer



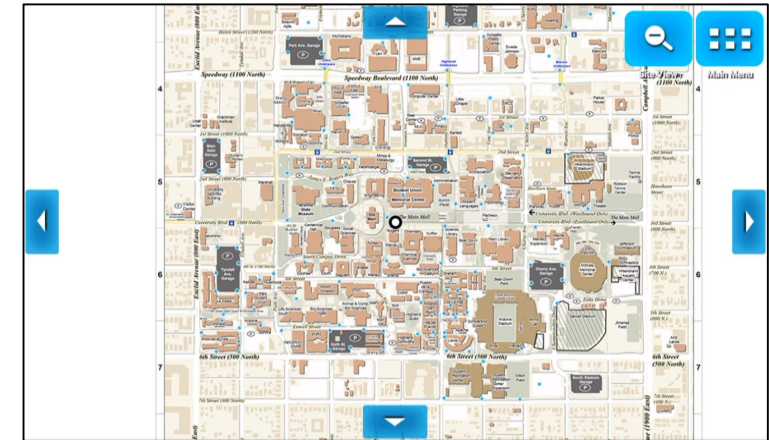

- Dispatch, PSO and Special Events will conduct standard Lot preparations and enforcement.
- Sequence: Inventory, Contact Permit Holders, Cite and Tow upon request from Special Events
- UAPD has 25 Reserved spaces located in the north end of Lot 4057 (20) and along the eastern wall (5). UAPD vehicles may display their temp 4057, annual 4057 or no permit at all. UAPD leadership directed them to display their permit but we will see if they comply.
- The 1700 Block of 1st Street, 1800 Block of 2nd Street, and Lot 4121 are made available for overflow to UAPD on a first come/space available basis
